About this trip

A relaxed 3-day Walcheren break for adults traveling with a dog. This version is built around one longer scenic walk near Veere, followed by a proper long lunch and a slow, flexible afternoon. All main stops are close to each other, keeping driving simple and the day easy to follow. Best for couples or friends who want fresh air, open views, and a day that feels active without being rushed.

*Walking best moment: **Late morning, when the coast walk is still the main event and lunch becomes a natural break afterward.***

*Notes: **Stronger adults + dog version with one real scenic walking block and less stop-hopping.***
